(a) to (d): A survey for a new line between Pandharpur-Lonand (109 km) was completed in 2009-10. As per the survey report, the cost assessed was `251 crore with negative ROR of 5%. The project could not be taken forward due to its unremunerative nature and huge throwforward of ongoing projects. However, to reassess its viability, updating exercise has been taken up.
