(a) to (c) There are over 40 skill development scheme being implemented by Ministry/Department of Government of India. A number of these schemes have provision for mandatory placement of a percentage of trainees. The Government of India on 15.07.2015 has notified the Common Norms for skill development programmes/schemes of the Government of India. The common norms provide for employment (both wages and self) on an annual basis of atleast 70% of the successfully certified trainees within three months of completion of training. These common norms would be applicable on all central skill development programmes/schemes with effect from 01.04.2016.
