(a) to (d) In lieu of vacation of spectrum occupied by Defence Services, the Government has given approval for construction of an exclusive dedicated OFC (Optical Fibre Cable) based communication network for Defence Services. In order to implement the network, the approved outlay is Rs 13, 334 crore.
