(a) whether the Government proposes to construct four lane road from Jhansi to Mirzapur and Sitapur to Lakhmipur Khiri *via* NH 24; and

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated for this purpose?

(a) & (b) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. At present, Government does not propose to construct four lane National Highway from Jhansi to Mirzapur via Banda and Allahabad. However, detailed project report (DPR) for 4- laning of NH-76 from Jhansi to Uttar Pradesh/Madhya Pradesh border near Mauranipur has been completed under National Highways Development Project (NHDP). Sitapur to Lakhimpur Khiri road is not a National Highway.
