(c): The payments for Railways' share from Central Road Fund for Railway Safety Works as well as reimbursement of losses on strategic lines and relief towards dividend and other concessions are provided as additionality over Gross Budgetary Support from the Demands for Grant of Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance. The dividend relief as per the existing accounting arrangements is provided on reimbursement basis and Railways are mandated to pay dividend to general revenue on gross basis. Payments for losses on strategic lines are also provided separately as per the existing arrangements as also the share of Central Road Fund.
