STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 52 BY SHRI G. HARI TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 24.02.2016 REGARDING RAIL OVER BRIDGES.

(a) & (b): At present, there are 1,156 sanctioned works for construction of 1,399 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) across the country.

(c) & (d): Fund for construction of Road Over Bridges (ROBs)/Road Under Bridges (RUBs)/Subways; elimination of level crossings and other safety works related to level crossings come from Central Road Fund (CRF) as a percentage of cess collected on petrol and diesel by Ministry of Finance. Present throwforward of these works is ₹ 31,700 crores approximately.
