

- (a) the per capita income of the country;
- (b) whether there is any increase in the per capita income in the country during the last three years; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a): As per the estimates of the Central Statistics Office (CSO), the per capita net national income of the country at current prices for the year 2015-16 is estimated to attain the level of Rs. 93231/-. The per capita net national income at constant (2011-12) prices for the year 2015-16 is estimated to attain the level of Rs. 77431/-.

(b) & (c): As per the CSO's estimates, the per capita net national income at current prices increased from Rs. 71050/- in 2012-13 to Rs. 79412/- in 2013-14 and further to Rs. 86879/- in 2014-15. The per capita net national income at constant (2011-12) prices increased from Rs. 65664/- in 2012-13 to Rs. 68867/- in 2013-14 and further to Rs. 72889/- in 2014-15.
