615. SHRI C.R. PATIL :

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

- (a) the number of widows who are getting benefits/ proposed to be given the benefit under the Skill Development Programme;
- (b) whether the branches for the skill development programme have started their works, State/ UT-wise; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SMT. MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI)

(a) to (c) : The Ministry has been administering 'Support to Training and Employment Programme for Women (STEP) Scheme' since 1986-87 as a 'Central Sector Scheme'. The STEP Scheme aims to provide skills that give employability to women and to provide competencies and skill that enable women to become self-employed/ entrepreneurs. The Scheme is intended to benefit women who are in the age group of 16 years and above across the country including widows.

Since this is a demand driven programme, proposals under this scheme are submitted by eligible institutions/ organizations including NGOs and the grant-in-aid is given to them directly, not to the State/ UT.

State/ UT-wise number of beneficiaries covered under the Scheme during the last three years and current year is at Annexure-I.

The State/UT-wise number of projects sanctioned during the last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-II.
