(a) to (d): No case of honey-trap involving defence personnel has come to notice of the Government during the last one year. However one case of IAF personnel LAC KK Ranjith involving cyber espionage has come to the notice of the Government. The official has been dismissed from service and facing criminal charges.

Detailed guidelines and advisories are issued from time to time to sensitise defence personnel in this regard to prevent such incidents.
