**ANTI-RABIES SERUM INJECTION**

**678. SHRI B.V. NAIK:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that anti-rabies serum injection was out of stock in various Government hospitals in Delhi in the last one year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons for not completing the procurement process before the out-ofstock situation of the injection;
- (c) whether any negligence has been noticed in this matter; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government for availability of the said injection in the Government hospitals?

**ANSWER

(a) to (d): In so far as three Central Government Hospital in Delhi namely, Safdarjung Hospital (SJH), Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital (RML) and Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC) and Associated Hospitals are concerned, it is not correct that anti-rabies serum injection was out of stock during last one year.
