- (b) if so, the details thereof and the names of such countries where the said personnel of CAPF have been deployed gender-wise?

- (a) & (b): Yes Madam, there are three types of UN assignments for which nominations are made by the Ministry of Home Affairs:
 - i) Deployment of UN CIVPOL (Civilian Police) Officers.
 - ii) Deployment of Officers on Secondment with UN Missions.
 - iii) Deployment of FPUs (Formed Police Units) from Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) with UN Missions.

50 (Male) Civilian Police Officers are deployed with UN Missions in Liberia, South Sudan, Afghanistan and Haiti.

03 (male) and 01 (Female) (Total 04) Police Officers are deployed on secondment mission with UN HQ New York, Lebanon and Italy.

840 (male) Formed Police Unit personnel are deployed with UN Mission in Haiti, Democratic Republic of Congo and Liberia.
