- (a) whether the Government has zeroed in on Punjab's low cost sewage system to management liquid waste and Tamil Nadu integrated solid waste disposal plan for the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which these systems are likely to be adapted in other States, including Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and West Bengal as part of SBM?

(a) to (c): No, Madam. Prioritization of the projects is being done at the State level. However, for the sewage system and solid waste management, Central assistance is available to the States under AMRUT and Swachh Bharat Mission.
