# A N S W E R MINISTER OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI RAM VILAS PASWAN)

(a) & (b): The Levy Sugar Price Equalisation Fund (LSPEF) claims are submitted by Department of Food and Supply, Rajasthan (DFSR) to Food Corporation of India (FCI) for payment. FCI has informed that no amount is outstanding for payment to DFSR. However, a claim of Rs.98.32 lakh for 2013-14 of Rajasthan State Food and Civil Supplies Corporation limited would be finalized only after receipt of levy sugar margin proposal for 2013-14, which is yet to be received from DFSR.
