- (a) whether there is a growing threat of drug menace in the country;
- (b) whether as per the World Drug Report, India is an important market for illegal drugs manufactured in South-East and South-West Asia;
- (c) if so, the number of drug trafficking cases registered during the last three years, State-wise;
- (d) whether only 16% of drugs seized by Government agencies were destroyed while the remaining 84% was probably re-circulated into the market on account of unholy connection between drug traffickers and enforcement agencies;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (f) whether the Supreme Court has given any direction in this regard, if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?
