#### EXPENDITURE ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of expenditure incurred by the Government on disaster mitigation and disasters relief separately during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to create a National Disaster Mitigation Fund;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the number of persons rescued by NDRF during the said period;
- (e) whether the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) has sought to increase its battalion from its present strength of 12 to 20 battalions and has also sought approval for creation of its own dedicated aviation wing;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the details of expenditure incurred by NDRF to procure equipments for disaster management along with the items of equipments procured therein?

#### **ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) Madam, the primary responsibility to address natural disasters rests with the State Governments. The Government of India supplements the efforts of the State Governments by providing logistic and financial support, wherever necessary. The State Governments are required to suitably address/undertake all necessary measures for prevention and mitigation as per their specific requirements.

Accordingly, the Government of India has released funds under State Disaster Relief Fund (excluding State share of CRF/SDRF) and National Disaster Relief Fund (NDRF) to the State Governments for management of relief necessitated by notified natural disasters, during the years 2012-13 to 2015-16, as given below:
