(a) & (b) The following Mail/Express trains were cancelled from 01st January to

**31st December 2015 over Indian Railways due to unforeseen reasons:** 

Major Factors	No. of trains cancelled	Remarks
Fire in Route Relay Interlocking cabin at Itarsi	2450	Trains passing via Etarsi cancelled from 17 June to 25 July 2015.
Accident on Itarsi- Khandwa section due to flash flood	543	Trains cancelled on Etarsi-Khandwa section from 5 <sup>th</sup> August 2015 to 21st August 2015.
Agitation by Gujjar community between Dumaria-Fatehsinghpura on Bayana-Kota section.	303	Trains cancelled on Mathura- Bombay central section from 21 <sup>st</sup> May2015 to29th May 2015.
Bhartiya Kissan Union & Sachcha Sauda Agitation in NR and NWR	208	Trains on affected section cancelled from 7-13 October 2015.
