GENERATING POWER BY RECYCLING WASTE

- (b) if so, the details of stations first intended to be covered;**

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Railways have taken action to set up pilot plants at New Delhi and Jaipur railway stations for disposal of waste arising, in an environment friendly manner. Electricity may also be produced as a by product in such plants which can be used in the railway stations including for lighting purposes, if found feasible.
