# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a): The Feasibility Reports of the following three prioritized Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridors have been prepared:
  - (i) Delhi-Gurgaon-Rewari-Alwar: 180 km
  - (ii) Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut: 90 km
  - (iii) Delhi-Sonepat-Panipat: 111 km
- (b): The funding pattern for implementation of the individual RRTS project has not been decided as the corridors have not been sanctioned.
