(a) to (c) Yes Madam. The Ministry of culture is responsible for preservation, development and promotion of both tangible and intangible cultural heritage of India, which it implements through its schemes and Organizations located in various States of the country.

The Ministry ensures preservation and conservation of centrally protected monuments of national importance through Archaeological Survey of India in terms of provisions contained in the Ancient Monuments & Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958 and amendments thereunder. Similarly, the Ministry promotes the museum movement in the country through various Museums under its administrative control and also through grant-in-aids under Museum Grant Scheme.

In order to preserve, promote and disseminate art and culture, the Ministry also extends financial support to individuals, groups of individuals and cultural organizations engaged in performing, visual and literary arts directly as well as through Organizations under its administrative control through schemes like-
