- (a) whether the mango production is likely to drop by 10 to 15 per cent due to unseasonal rain this year, if so, the details thereof indicating the production of mango during each of last three years and the estimated production during the current year in major mango producing States, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is considering any proposal to provide assistance to the affected farmers and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the prices of mango are likely to soar in the domestic market; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps proposed in this regard?

(a): No, Madam. According to the information received from the states so far, there is likely to be an increase of 2.1 % in mango production in the current year, 2015-16 as compared to the previous year, 2014-15. The details of All India mango production are as under:-

- (b): Except for Telangana, which has reported decrease in mango production due to unseasonal rains and hot weather, the production in other states is likely to be either normal or better than previous year. As per the report from the Government of Telangana, they will provide assistance to the affected farmers as per State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) norms.
- (c) & (d): In view of higher production in the current year, it is unlikely that the prices of mango will soar in the domestic markets.
