(a) The plant-wise details of the projects under implementation in the public sector at present are as follows:-

<b>Name of the Project</b>	<b>Crude Steel Capacity</b>
NMDC Integrated Steel Plant at Nagarnar, Chhattisgarh (NMDC)	3.0 Million Tonnes Per Annum (MTPA) (New Plant)
Expansion of Bhilai Steel Plant, Bhilai, Chhattisgarh (SAIL)	Expansion from 3.93 MTPA to 7.0 MTPA
Modernisation & Upgradation of Vizag Steel Plant (RINL)	Expansion from 6.3 MTPA to 7.3 MTPA

(b)to(e): Steel, being a deregulated sector, the decisions for expansion of steel plants are taken by the individual public sector companies based on commercial considerations and market dynamics. The role of the Government as facilitator is to help in resolving the issues with the State Governments and other Ministries/ Departments to expedite the implementation.
