*182. SHRI MULLAPALLY RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is implementing schemes to set up/upgrade the National/State Cancer Institutes (SCI) and Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCC) at district levels;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the locations where such institutes/centres have been set up/upgraded and the expenditure incurred thereon, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether the Government has received a number of proposals for new centres and upgradation of the existing centres under the scheme from various States/UTs including Kerala, if so, the details and present status thereof, State/UT-wise; and

(d) whether adequate budgeting provisions have been made for the purpose and if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 182* FOR 06TH MAY, 2016

(a) to (d): Government of India is implementing "Tertiary Care for Cancer" scheme to set up/establish State Cancer Institutes (SCI) and Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCC) in different parts of the country. The maximum assistance inclusive of State share for SCI is upto Rs.120 crore and for TCCC it is upto Rs.45 crore. The State share is 40% while for NE and Hill States it is 10%.

Under the said scheme, 47 proposals have been received from 26 States and UTs which are listed at **Annexure I**. Out of these proposals, 14 proposals from 13 States - 7 for setting up of SCI and 7 for setting up of TCCCs have been approved and funds have been released during 2014-15 and 2015-16 (**Annexure II**). The defficiencies in the other proposals have been communicated to the institutions.

Two proposals have been received from the State of Kerala. The proposal for setting up of TCCC at Government Medical College, Kozhikode, has been approved and the 1st installment of Government of India share amounting to Rs. 25.03 crore has been released to State Government. One more proposal has been received for setting up of SCI at Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram. The proposal is under advanced stage of consideration.

During the current Financial Year, an amount of Rs. 300 crore has been allocated for the scheme.
