(c) the action taken by the Government in this regard along with the measures taken to check recurrence of such incidents?

**STATEMENT IN REPLY TO THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*22
FOR 26.04.2016.**

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Details are as under:-

- (i) Two FIRs, No. 43/2016 u/s 147, 148, 149, 427, 323 RPC and No. 45/2016 u/s 147, 148, 149, 336, 323, 353 RPC have been registered at Police Station, Nageen, Srinagar.**
- (ii) State Government ordered a Magisterial Enquiry to enquire into the incident at National Institute of Technology (NIT) Srinagar.**
- (iii) A three-member team of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) visited NIT to assess the situation.**
- (iv) NIT, Srinagar constituted a fact finding committee to look into the circumstances leading to the incident and a committee headed by a Senior Professor for addressing student grievances.**
- (v) State Government has established a 24x7 helpline at P/S Nageen, Srinagar to address security concerns of students at NIT.**
- (vi) Adequate security has been provided to the NIT campus.**
- (vii) A joint mechanism between Administration, Police and NIT has been put in place to pre-empt any such incident in future.**
