The Sudhir Chandra Committee's recommendation, alongwith required modifications as accepted by Railway Board and further modified from time to time are followed by Railways, Central Organisation for Modernisation of Workshops (COFMOW), Integral Coach Factory and Rail Coach Factory. However, Public Sector Undertakings under Ministry of Railways are following their own guidelines approved by their Board of Directors taking into consideration the requirement of funding agencies and instructions of the client.
