Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether several railway stations across the country have been identified as sensitive stations;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof, division-wise;**
- (c) whether any Committee has been set up to study the security system of these sensitive stations and for their upgradation and if so, the details thereof;**
- (d) whether any report has been presented by the Committee in this regard; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof and whether any measures have been taken for the time bound implementation of the scheme regarding security system as per the report and if so, the details in this regard?**

STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 53 BY SHRI AJAY NISHAD TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 27.04.2016 REGARDING SECURITY SYSTEM AT SENSITIVE STATIONS

(a): Yes, Madam. 202 railway stations have been identified as sensitive for the purpose of installation of an Integrated Security System (ISS) over Indian Railways.

(b): Division-wise position is Appended.

(c) &(d): A seven member expert committee was constituted by the Ministry of Railways in 2008 to formulate an Integrated Security System to strengthen surveillance mechanism at identified sensitive stations. Based on the report of the Expert Committee and further deliberations, ISS has been conceptualized as comprising of following components which together provide multiple checking of passengers and its baggage from the point of entry in the station premises till boarding of train-

- Internet protocol based close circuit television (CCTV) camera**
- Access control**
- Personal and baggage screening system**
- Bomb Detection and Disposal System**

(e): CCTV cameras have already been installed over 89 railway stations under ISS. Besides above, 27 under-vehicle scanning system and 114 baggage scanners have also been provided at nominated stations under ISS. Close monitoring is being done and all the zonal railways have been advised to ensure early implementation of the Integrated Security System at identified sensitive stations.
