- (b) if so, the details of target fixed and achievements made during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UTwise;
- (c) whether the textile workers in the country are facing problems due to recession in the sector, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the remedial steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government to protect the interest of textile workers?

STATEMENT IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *64 FOR ANSWER ON 28.04.2016 REGARDING 'PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS' BY SHRI AJAY NISHAD:.

(a) & (b): Production of textiles and garments is predominantly in the private sector. Therefore, the Government does not prescribe specific production targets for the textile and garmenting industry.

(c) & (d): Increasing production of textiles garments through various policy interventions is among the foremost objectives of the Government. The production of major textile items during the last three years and the current year is given in the table below:-

The details of State-wise production of spun yarn, man-made fibre and filament yarn are given in Annexure-I & II respectively.

The government has not received any report of textile workers facing problems due to recession in the sector. The data available on production and export shows an increasing trend during the last three years and current year.

In order to strengthen the textile industry in the country and to protect the interests of textile workers, Government has launched various policy initiatives and schemes, such as Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Schemes for the development of the Powerloom Sector, Schemes for Technical textiles, Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Integrated Skill Development Scheme. These are intended to strengthen the Indian textile sector and generate employment opportunities for textile workers.
