Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to expand/develop the infrastructure in shipping sector in the country;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof along with the details of schemes proposed/under implementation;
- (c) the locations identified/proposed to be developed under the said schemes along with the financial implications involved therein;
- (d) the extent to which employment opportunities are likely to be generated as a result thereof; and
- (e) whether some foreign countries are also extending their support for the purpose and if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.66 TO BE ANSWERED ON 28TH APRIL, 2016 RAISED BY SHRI AJAY MISRA TENI, MP REGARDING “DEVELOPMENT OF SHIPPING SECTOR”.

(a)to(c):Yes, Madam. At present 37 projects under Public Private Partnership (PPP) and 32 non PPP projects involving an investment of Rs.44,585.22 Crores and capacity addition of 463.60 Million Tonnes Per Annum (MTPA) have been taken up in twelve Major Ports. The details of these projects are **annexed**.

(d) These projects when completed will lead to creation of significant employment opportunities. The extent of new employment opportunity created will depend on the nature of the project and level of mechanisation.

(e) Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) upto 100% under automatic route is allowed in the Port sector. A number of reputed foreign companies have been participating in the bids for projects in ports, particularly on PPP basis for container terminals and capital dredging projects.
