The force level preparedness is a dynamic and continuous process based on various factors. All efforts are made to ensure availability of assets as per requirements. The induction of ships and submarines is carried out in accordance with the Maritime Capability Perspective Plan and Long Term Integrated Perspective Plan 2012-27.

The details of funds utilised for the development and commissioning of various Indian Navy ships and submarines during the 12th Five Year Plan is as under:

There is no budget allocation to Indian Navy for indigenous research and development of ships and submarines. However, the R&D for ships and submarines is carried out by DRDO within their overall Defence R&D budget. The details of Revised Estimates for Defence R&D budget is as below:
