(a) to (c): The Central Government has funded Central Forensic Science Laboratories in various parts of the country for aiding in scientific investigation of crimes. Higher education in various sciences, including forensic science, is imparted by Universities. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that there are 29 universities having Department of Forensic Sciences and offering different courses imparting education in forensic science in the country.
