The Ease of Doing Business Dashboard will facilitate States to report progress made by them on State Level Business Reforms Action Plan and validation of responses received from the States/UTs by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion. It also has a feature to identify and disseminate information about the good practices followed by the States/UTs. The State Governments/UTs have been provided with username and password to enable them to upload the progress on the State Level Business Reform Action Plan Dashboard (<http://eodb.dipp.gov.in>)
