Vacant Posts

123. PROF. RICHARD HAY:

Will the Minister of Human Resource Development be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that various posts of non-teaching staff are laying vacant in some Central Universities particularly in the School of Open Learning under Delhi University despite the availability of eligible candidates;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor and the remedial steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) the time by which these are likely to be filled up?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c): The University Grants Commission(UGC) has informed that out of 34,272 sanctioned non-teaching posts in 39 Central Universities under the purview of UGC, including School of Open Learning under University of Delhi, 10,015 non-teaching posts are lying vacant as on 1.1.2016. Occurring of vacancies and filling them is a continuous process. Ministry of Human Resource Development and UGC have repeatedly urged Central Universities to fill up the vacancies. However, the onus of filling up the non-teaching posts lies on Central Universities which are autonomous bodies created under Acts of Parliament.
