- (c) whether there is any proposal to modernise Gurukuls in the country and to promote research on the Sanskrit and Vedic literature;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon;
- (e) the time by which modernisation work of Gurukuls in the country would be completed; and
- (f) whether the structure of IITs has also been revised in the recent past and if so, the details thereof?

## ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b): Ministry of Human Resource Development commissioned a study on development of Sanskrit in various educational institutions under the Chairmanship of Shri N.Gopalaswami, former Chief Election Commissioner. The report of the Committee available http://mhrd.gov.in/sites/upload\_files/mhrd/files/Report-CVRM.pdf. The report inter-alia suggested that IITs may facilitate study of Science & Technology as reflected in Sanskrit literature along with inter-disciplinary study of Sanskrit and modern subject. Accordingly, IITs have been requested to teach Sanskrit language especially with reference to study of works which contain scientific knowledge.
