The National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2005 developed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), as per the mandate of the National Policy on Education 1986 (as modified in 1992), sets the guidelines and direction for the development of syllabi and textbooks at all the school stages. The present syllabi developed by the NCERT are in conformity with the NCF, 2005.
