Autonomous Colleges

1346. SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the scheme of autonomous colleges is being implemented by the University Grants Commission (UGC) since the Fourth Five Year Plan;
- (b) if so, the number and names of the Universities which are implementing the system, State-wise; and
- (c) the number of Universities which have introduced the System, State-wise along with the number of autonomous colleges/institutions?

(a): Yes, Madam. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that the scheme of Autonomous Colleges have been formulated during the Fourth Five Year Plan (1969-73) in pursuance of the recommendations of the Education Commission (1964-66).
