ASSESSMENT OF THE CONDITION OF TRIBALS

†1356: DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted or proposes to conduct any on-the-spot assessment of the condition of tribals to ensure their actual development across the country;
- (b) if so, the details of such assessments made during each of the last three years and the outcome thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government holds discussions with the representatives of the tribals at the time of reviewing the schemes made for them;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the further steps being taken by the Government for improving the quality of life of the tribals across the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS
(SHRI JUAL ORAM)

(a): Yes, Madam.

(b): The assessment of condition of Scheduled Tribes (STs) across the country is made through decennial Census conducted by Office of Registrar General, India, large scale sample surveys conducted by National Sample Survey Office (NSSO), Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, various surveys conducted by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Agricultural Census conducted by Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, etc. State / UT wise data pertaining to STs based on Census and different surveys are at **Annexures I to XI**.

(c) & (d): Under the provisions of “Operational Guidelines for Formulation, Implementation and Monitoring of Tribal Sub-Plan and Article 275(1) grants” issued by the Ministry in the month of March, 2014 a Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) consisting of Secretary (Tribal Affairs) as chairman with representatives of NITI Aayog, Financial Advisor and representatives of concerned States as members / invitees has been constituted. Through the process of PAC, detailed discussions are made with the State Government representatives of tribal development departments at the time of appraisal and approval of the proposals received from the States for delivery of goods and services to the tribals. During the year 2014-15, 18 PAC meetings and during 2015-16, 22 such meetings were held. This has helped in ensuring consultation with the States, convergence of various schemes of the Ministry, transparency in the process of appraisal and fund releases and ensuring optimal utilization of financial resources.

(e): Government has adopted a multi-pronged strategy for overall development of tribal people across the country, which includes support for education, health, sanitation, water supply, skill development, livelihood, etc. Major part of infrastructure development and provision of basic amenities in tribal areas / regions in the country is carried out through various schemes / programmes of concerned Central Ministries and State Governments concerned, while the Ministry of Tribal Affairs provides additive to these initiatives by way of plugging critical gaps.

Erstwhile Planning Commission has issued comprehensive Guidelines for utilization of Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP) funds by the States on 18.06.2014. The Guidelines, inter alia, provide for the measures to formulate perspective plan and annual plan after conducting critical gap analysis to assess the deprivation of STs on identified Socio-Economic parameters.

As a part of Vanbandhu Kalyan Yojana (VKY) Strategy adopted since 2014-15, the State Governments have been insisted upon to formulate long term perspective plan based on the gap analysis with outcome oriented approach in the fourteen thematic areas including livelihood, education, health & sanitation, drinking water, irrigation, housing, electricity, roads & connectivity, sports, culture, security, economic development and urban development in consultation with their line Departments and field level units.
