(a) to (d): The Government is in the process of framing a New Education Policy (NEP) for which it has carried out year-long consultations on 33 identified themes across School and Higher Education. A 'Committee for Evolution of the New Education Policy' has been constituted by the Govt. of India for drafting the New Education Policy (NEP). One of the issues being considered by the Committee relates to the theme of eradication of alcohol and drug abuse also.
