## PRODUCTION OF HORTICULTURE CROPS

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether despite the deficit monsoon, unseasonal rains and hailstorm in the major parts of the country, the production of horticulture crops has outpaced the production of foodgrains since 2012-13 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether horticulture production has shown continuous increase while the foodgrain output has reported a decline in 2014-15 as compared to that of 2013-14 and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether it is a fact that Karnataka is leading in floriculture production accounting for 75% of India's total flower production and if so, the details thereof?

## **ANSWER**

(a): Yes, Madam. Despite the deficit monsoon, unseasonal rains and hailstorm in the major part of the country, the production of horticulture crops have outpaced the production of foodgrains since 2012-13 as may be seen in the table below:

- (b): Yes, Madam, there has been an increase of 1.3% in horticulture production and reduction of 4.9% in foodgrains production in 2014-15 as compared to 2013-14.
- (c): No, Madam. Karnataka is the second in floriculture production with 13.6 % share in India's total flower production.
