Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal seeking financial assistance and incentives under Ambedkar Scheme for Social Integration and if so, the details thereof, Statewise including Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the details of proposals sanctioned, rejected and pending alongwith the financial assistance and incentives provided, Statewise including Andhra Pradesh; and
- (c) the reasons for pendency or rejection of the said proposals?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI VIJAY SAMPLA)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The details of the proposals received, sanctioned, rejected /sought clarifications from the State Governments/ Applicants, along with the financial assistance and incentives provided to them, State-wise including Andhra Pradesh are at **Annexure.**

At present no proposal is pending for the release of financial assistance to the beneficiary.

- (c): The various reasons for rejection of the cases, due to non-fulfilment of the Scheme Guidelines, are as follows:
- (i) Non-registration of marriages under the Hindu marriage Act, 1955;
- (ii) Non-submission of the application through the State Government;
- (iii) Non-submission of Caste certificate;
- (iv) Non-submission of Income certificate;
- (v) Non-submission of proposal within stipulated time of one year of marriage.
