SECURITY RELATED EXPENDITURE

1423. SHRIMATI RITA TARAI:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Rs. 19184.67 lakh has not yet been released by the Government to the States under Security Related Expenditure (SRE) Scheme for the period from the Financial Year 2005-2006 to 2014-2015;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps taken to release the said amount to the State Governments?

(a) to (c): Under the SRE Scheme, security related expenditure are reimbursed to the State Government of J&K, States affected with Left Wing Extremists and NE States except Sikkim and Mizoram.

SRE claims of these States are reimbursed only for the items admissible under the SRE guidelines and verification of relevant records of the SRE Claims by the Internal Audit Wing of Ministry of Home Affairs.

During the Financial Year 2005-2006 to 2014-15, a total of Rs.6282.01 Crore has been released by the Government of India to the concerned States.
