- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) Following the production of first cloned buffalo calf in 2009, several more cloned buffalo calves have been produced using donor cells obtained from skin, embryonic stem cells, seminal plasma and urine. All the calves were produced by hand guided cloning technique.
- (c) When successfully applied, cloning technology can be used for fast multiplication of elite buffaloes and outstanding buffalo bulls.
