- (a) whether various border areas in the country including Pakistan and China borders are guarded by the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether recruitment and conditions of services of the said Forces are governed by rules and regulations of Police;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to reconsider pensions, promotions and facilities being provided to BSF, CRPF, ITBP, SSB and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (b) Yes, Madam. The details of Central Armed Police Forces( CAPFs) and Assam Rifles, which guard various border areas in the country including Pakistan and China borders are as under:
