**(e) the details of the steps taken to revamp the intelligence gathering systems by modernizing the intelligence department?**

**(a) to (d) : The 9<sup>th</sup> National Security Advisory Board (NSAB) completed its tenure in January, 2015. Reconstitution of the NSAB is going on.**

**(e) : The Central Government has established the Multi Agency Centre (MAC) and Subsidiary Multi Agency Centres (SMACs) across the country to collate analyze, disseminate and pursue intelligence inputs on near real time basis. Inputs are shared through this network with all member agencies including security agencies and law enforcement agencies of the states. The upgradation/modernization of the intelligence gathering system is on going process.**
