- (b) & (c): The States/UT-wise funds allocation, utilization and number of beneficiaries under SHC since its inception year 2015-16 and under SHM for the last three years and the current year are given at Annexure I & II respectively.
- (d) & (e): Government has launched awareness campaign to popularize soil health management amongst the farmers in the country through print advertisements, TV sports, radio jingles, organization of World Soil Day, workshops etc.
