(a) whether the Government is providing incentives/subsidy for promotion and cultivation of oilseeds, pulses, oil palm and maize under certain existing agricultural schemes;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the norms of the subsidy thereunder; and

(c) the details of incentives/subsidy given to farmers for the cultivation of these crops during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Government provides incentives for promotion and cultivation of oilseeds & oil palm under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) and pulses and maize under National Food Security Mission (NFSM). Under these schemes assistance is provided to farmers for various interventions viz. seed production/distribution, transfer of technology including cluster demonstration and training, efficient water application tools, micro nutrients & soil amelioration, plant protection chemicals, farm machineries and farm implements etc. The pattern of assistance under NFSM and NMOOP are at Annexure-I & II.

(c): State-wise allocations and release of funds under NFSM, NMOOP, Integrated scheme for development of Oilseeds, Oil Palm and Maize (ISOPOM) and Oil Palm Area Expansion Programme (OPAE) during the last three years and the current year are at Annexure-III & IV.
