- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of children who participated in the programme?

(a) & (b): The Government has launched 'Wattan Ko Jano' initiative for the orphans, children from militancy hit families and weaker sections of the society in Jammu and Kashmir. Under the programme groups of educated youth in the age group of 15-24 years visit various parts of the country and are exposed to the diverse social and cultural heritage of the country. The groups during their trip interact both at inter-state and intra-state level and participate in cultural activities at different places. Under the program 769 children have participated so far.
