- (a) whether the Government has any proposal for creation of a Higher Education Financing Agency in the country;

- (d) If so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard; and

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The Government has decided to set up a Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) with an initial capital base of Rs. 1,000 crores and funds from the market and supplement them with donations on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds. These funds will be used to finance improvement in infrastructure in the top institutions and will be serviced through internal accruals.
