Sports Projects in Karnataka

1527. SHRI B.S. YEDIYURAPPA:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of sports projects being implemented by the Union Government in Karnataka in the field of Youth Affairs and Sports during the last two years and the current year; and
- (b) the details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred on each of such projects during the said period in the State?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) & (b) The Union Government through the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has released an amount of Rs.1.80 crore for construction of a Multi-purpose indoor hall at Belgaum and Rs.0.75 crore for Laying of synthetic athletic track at Chamarajanagar, Chamarajanagar District, Karnataka during 2014-15 under Urban Sports Infrastructure Scheme (USIS). The Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the entire released amount have been received. No projects have been sanctioned during 2015-16 and in the current financial year.

In addition, an amount of Rs. 5.91 crore was released during 2014-15 and Rs. 1.72 crore during 2015-16 for organizing competitions under the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan (RGKA). UC for the grant released during 2014-15 has been received and the UC for the grant released during 2015-16 is pending. No funds have been sanctioned during the current financial year.
