(a): The National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) is being implemented in 33 States/ Union Territories and covers 72.45 crore persons against the intended coverage of 81.34 crore persons, or two-third of the population, as per Census, 2011.

(b) & (c): No study has been conducted on outcome of NFSA and its impact on improvement in the standard of nutrition of children and women.
