### **FUNDS TO URBAN BODIES**

### No. 1611 SHRI BHAIRON PRASAD MISHRA:

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated by the Government of India for the urban bodies in this year's budget to carry out the developmental work;
- (b) the details of the heads under which these funds are likely to be spent; and
- (c) whether any guidelines have been issued for this purpose and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU)

- (a) :Rs.24,843.34 crore have been allocated in Budget 2016-17 for the urban local bodies.
- (b) :Rs. 4090.50 crore have been allocated for Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT); Rs. 3205 crore for Development of 100 Smart Cities; Rs. 2300 crores for

the Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan (Urban); Rs. 100 crore for Lumpsum Provision Scheme for North East Region; Rs. 150 crore for North Eastern Region Urban Development Programme (NERUDP); and Rs.14,997.84 crore have been allocated for devolution to Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) as per the recommendations of the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FFC).

(c) :The grants are to be spent on components indicated in the respective scheme guidelines issued by the Ministry of Urban Development and the Ministry of Finance. These guidelines also provide for the modalities for release & monitoring of the grants. The guidelines are available on the websites of the Ministries of Urban Development and Finance.
