Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has asked the Secretaries of all Union Ministries and heads of Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) to submit reports on the exact number of employees from the minority communities, especially Muslims in their respective offices;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time fixed for submission of such report;
- (c) whether all the Ministries and CPSUs have submitted their reports;
- (d) if so, the details thereof showing increase or decrease in the number of such employees from minority communities; and
- (e) the corrective steps taken or being taken if any, by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister & Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (e): The Department of Personnel & Training has been collecting annual data on recruitment of minority communities since 2006-2007.

Accordingly, this year also the Central Ministries/ Departments have been requested in April 2016 to furnish the annual data for 2015-2016.

However, no segregated data on recruitment is collected religion-wise.

As per data received for the year 2013-14, 7.89% of minorities were recruited. As per data received for the year 2014-15, 8.56% of minorities have been recruited in Government Services.
